SUITCASE:

One Large size suitcase and one backpack/small bag

CLOTHES:

Grubby Rec clothes for 3 days

- ALSM Camp T-shirt (these will be given upon check on June 20th. If you did not pre-register you may not receive a t-shirt, only a small number of extra t-shirts will be made so make sure you arrive early to claim yours.)
- Shorts (Must be finger length OR mid-thigh when standing. If your shorts are too short you will be asked to change)
- T-shirts (must cover mid-driff and must NOT contain designs of any objectionable nature)
- Tanks (must be wider straps NO spaghetti straps)

- Tennis shoes MUST be worn for certain outdoor Rec games
- NO two piece swim suits. One piece swim suits may be worn underneath Rec clothes
- **We do not know our team color as of right now but we will update you with more info when it becomes available so you can prepare.**

Regular summer clothes for 4 days

- Shorts (Must be finger length OR mid-thigh when standing. If your shorts are too short you will be asked to change)
- T-shirts (must cover mid-driff and must NOT contain designs of any objectionable nature)
- Tanks (must be wider straps NO spaghetti straps)
- Flip flops/Sandals/Regular shoes
- Hats may be worn during the day but not to evening Chapel

Evening Chapel appropriate clothes for 3 days

- All clothes must be clean
- Jeans, Pants (Shorts, may be worn to chapel however, they must be an appropriate length)
- Girls-Dresses and skirts, if you prefer are allowed but MUST be knee length and dresses may NOT be backless or see through
- Short sleeve or long sleeve shirts (NO tank tops, and again ALL shirts MUST cover your mid-driff and MUST be appropriate)
- Hoodie for cool nights
- Nice shoes/sandals/or flip flops

Other Clothes for 4 days

- Pajamas
- Underwear
- Socks

TOILETRIES:

- Toothbrush/paste
- Soap
- Deodorant
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Brush/comb
- Gel/Mousse/Hair Spray
- Straightener/Curling Iron/Blow Dryer
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Lotion
- Body spray/Perfume/Cologne

OTHER ITEMS:

- **ANY MISSING CAMP FORMS!** If you did not turn in a medical form or a Trip Rules form you are not permitted to board the van!
- **Spending money** ALL meals are provided on this trip! Yay!!! Spending money for snacks is NOT included & is up to you to provide that. There is a camp snack shack where things can be purchased after service.
- Towels & Wash cloths
- ALL BEDDING such as sleeping bag, sheet, blanket, and pillow
- Bible (The Bible App does not count as you will not have your cell phones during service.)
- Note Pad & Pen
- Camera/phone camera
- **Movies on portable devices must be appropriate.** If you are caught watching an inappropriate video your cell phone will be taken away for the duration of the trip.
- **Music on devices MUST be clean!**
- **Medications** (prescription or over the counter) ALL medications **MUST** have original packaging and labels and turned into leadership upon check-in and checked in with the Camp nurse upon arrival to Cedaredge.
- Snacks (No more than 2 grocery bags full)
- Cell Phone and charger. Phones will be allowed during the trip but NOT during service times or small group times. Services will begin around 7:00 pm Tuesday through Thursday and will continue past 9:00 pm. All cell phones will be turned into a leader at the beginning of service and will be returned after service to avoid distraction. If at any point during the trip a cell phone becomes a distraction it will be taken away by a leader and returned to parents upon returning home. Please keep in mind cell phone service is not the greatest at Cedaredge. Also students are NOT allowed to use other student's cell phones for any reason. If a student needs to use a phone other than their own they may ask an ALSM leader.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- No Weapons of any kind (examples include but are not limited to: pocket knives, knives, guns, ect...)
- No Fireworks
- No Illegal or legal drugs
- No Alcohol
- No clothing with profanity, alcohol, legal or illegal drugs, substances, or anything of a questionable nature.
- No Energy Drinks (Rockstars, Monsters, Redbull, ect... Coffee IS allowed)
- No Video games systems/consoles/TV's
- Anything questionable. If you have to question it leave it at home or check with Pastor Jeremie first.

ALSM TRIP RULES:

- Students are not allowed to be alone with the opposite sex at any time
- Notify a leader if you need to walk away from the group (example: bathroom break)
- NO PRANKS!
- No Profanity
- No public or private displays of affection (for this policy please see Andrea Hartrup)
